Sonoma Plaza location awards 10,000th Pomagranate Martini guest with a surprise

Sonoma, CA – January 29, 2007 - Mary's Pizza Shack, a legendary family restaurant with 3 bars, just announced that they have three award-winning martinis. Having participated in the Sonoma Valley Martini Madness Festival for the past 3 years, Mary's Pizza Shack has placed in the top three every year.


The latest winner from the January 2007 Martini Madness contest was the Portini, the 'Jewel of the Valley'. This unique combination, made by Mary's Pizza Shack's own Bar Manager Jay Busse, is made exclusively with Sonoma Valley ingredients and stole the hearts of the audience. This martini combines Ketel One Vodka, St. Francis Port and Marion Berry syrup with a unique toothpick of an olive soaked in port wine, Asiago cheese from Vella Cheese Company, and toasted bread from Basque bread of Sonoma. Mary's Pizza Shack's 2nd place winner in 2006 is the Metropolitan Martini, made with Ketel One Vodka, lemon-lime juice, Cointreau, Black Currant Syrup and splash of Gloria Ferrer Champagne.

Mary's Pizza Shack's signature (and first-place award-winning) drink is the Pomegranate Martini, made with Ketel One Vodka, lime and lemon juices, pomegranate syrup and a splash of Gloria Ferrer Champagne. On Friday, January 19th, the Sonoma Plaza Store served its 10,000th Pomegranate Martini since its inception and victory in the 2005 Martini Madness contest. Mary's Pizza Shack awarded the 10,000th Pomegranate Martini guest, Rena Nelson, with a \$100 gift card from Mary's, four VIP passes to Gloria Ferrer and a bottle of Gloria Ferrer Sparkling Wine. On hand to celebrate were David and Eva Brown of Gloria Ferrer, the winner Rena Nelson and Jay Busse, Mary's Bar Manager.

Mary's Pizza Shack opened their first bar on Sonoma Plaza in May 2004 and based on the success, the Mary's Pizza Shack family decided to expand their restaurant bars in Dixon and Rohnert Park in 2006. Guests can enjoy a Martini ("Shackatini"), Margarita, Mojito, coffee drink, wine or beer from the new bars. The full bars include specialty and seasonal drinks, as well as an expanded wine and beer list.
